PHASE 1 – PRELIMINARY EXAMINATION

You will face the preliminary exam first which is an objective test of **125 Questions** and each question shall carry **4 Marks**. The question will comprise of objective type questions from all the below-mentioned acts in the mains syllabus

PHASE 2 – MAINS EXAMINATION

The exam is consists of five papers:

PAPER I – CIVIL LAW I (200 Marks)

You will be asked a question based on the following:

- Code of Civil Procedure
- Indian Contract Act
- Indian Partnership Act
- Sales of Goods Act
- Specific Relief Act
- Indian Evidence Act
- Punjab Courts Act
- Haryana Urban (Control of Rent & Eviction) Act, 1973.

PAPER-II – CIVIL LAW II (200 MARKS)

You will be asked a question based on the following:

- Hindu Law
- Mohammedan Law (Study the customary law of Haryana and Punjab also)
- Law of Registration
- Limitation Act

PAPER III – CRIMINAL LAW (200 Marks)

You will be asked a question based on the following:

- Indian Penal Code
- Criminal Procedure Code
- Indian Evidence Act

SECTION IV: ENGLISH

- Essay (100 Marks)
- Precis Writing (25 Marks)
- Comprehension (25 Marks)
- Corrections (25 Marks)
- Words & Phrases (25 Marks)

(To make sentences of the given words and phrases)

PAPER V: LANGUAGE HINDI (100 MARKS)

The standard of Hindi paper shall be that of the matriculation examination of the Haryana Board. It shall comprise of:

- Translation of English passage into Hindi. (20 MARKS)

- Hindi Essay, Idioms and Corrections (50 MARKS)
